

Swimming at Roxeth Primary School

Swimming and water safety is an extremely important part of the P.E. curriculum at Roxeth Primary School and another way of helping children to lead healthy and active lives.

Throughout the academic year, pupils currently in Year 4 attend swimming lessons at John Lyon School's swimming pool once a week. We expect all children to leave Roxeth Primary School having reached the National Curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety by the end of Year 6.

Pupils are grouped according to their ability and are taught to:

- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- Use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- Perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
