English

Spellings

x They are tested every Wednesday.

Your child must bring their spelling book into school every Wednesday.

Maths

We will be following the National curriculum for maths

The strands are:

- X Number Sense-place value, decimals, fractions, money problems
- X Addition and subtraction- column method
- X Multiplicative Reasoning-all times tables and related division facts
- X Geometric Reasoning-coordinates, movement
- X Shape-Quadrilaterals, right angles, symmetry
- X Measurement-digital time, converting units of measure

Maths

The Multiplication Tables Check is a Key Stage 2 assessment introduced by the Government to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4.

The purpose of the Multiplication Tables Check is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided.

Your child will sit the Multiplication Tables Check in June. Further information to follow later in the year about the exact day of the Check.

- X Will take place during the month of June 2024
- X Children in Year 4 must know all times tables up to 12 x 12
- X 25 questions 6 seconds per question
- X Daily practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) is essential the 'Soundcheck' game in TTRS is very similar to the test
