The items will need to be washed and ready to use.



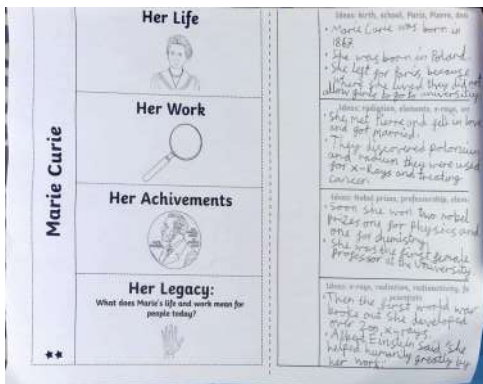
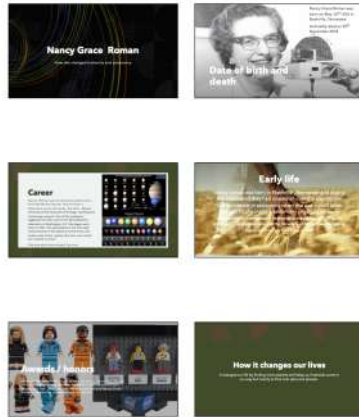
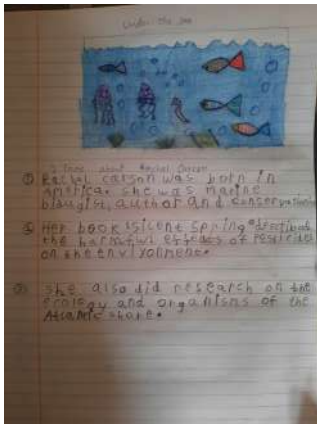

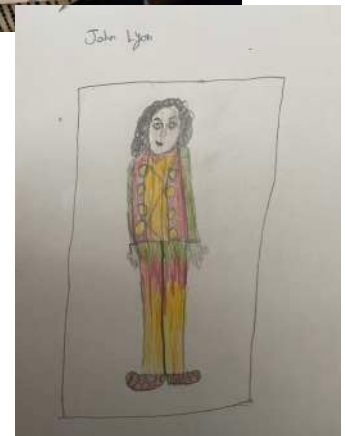
SCIENCE

Children in all year groups have been researching scientists related to their current science unit. Here are some examples of our amazing research from Years 1, 3 and 5.



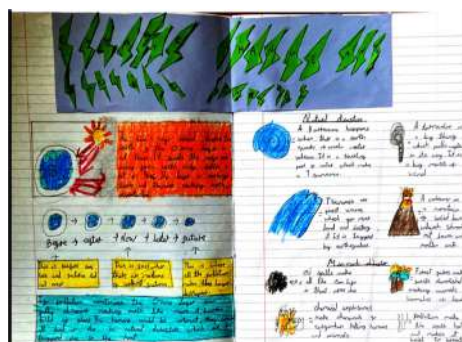
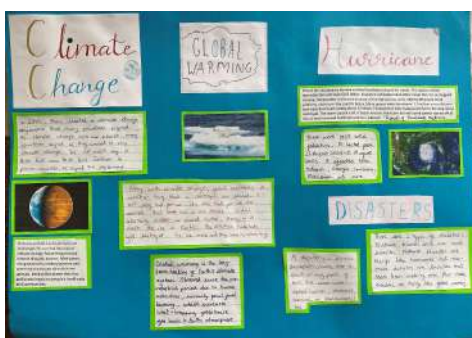
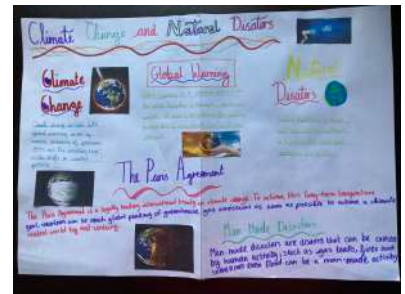
HISTORY

Year 6 produced some wonderful posters displaying all they had learned during their geography topic of 'Climate Change and Natural Disasters.'



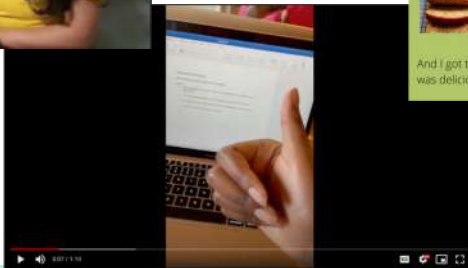
ENGLISH
